

Safeguarding children and adults

Safeguarding is a concept that was introduced several decades ago in the United Kingdom and refers to the collection of measures that ensure groups such as children, young people, and vulnerable adults are protected from abuse, harm and neglect in society.

If someone shares with you a concern about their or somebody else's physical, sexual or emotional well-being:

Do

- Remain calm, approachable and receptive
- Take it seriously
- Listen carefully, without interrupting
- Acknowledge you understand how difficult this may be
- ✓ Offer reassurance it is the right thing to tell someone
- ✓ Tell them what will happen next
- ✓ Make a written record of exactly what has been said and when
- Report

Don't

- × Promise complete confidentiality
- X Ask leading or probing questions
- Investigate
- X Discuss with people who do not need to know
- Delay in reporting the disclosure to the relevant authority/authorities
